AN ACT to amend the Tax Law, in relation to exempting pellet fuel from sales and compensating use taxes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. [Subdivision \(a\) of section 1115 of the Tax Law](#) is amended

by adding a new paragraph 44 to read as follows: (44) Wood pellet fuel sold to a person for residential heating

purposes in a pellet fuel appliance. § 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of a sales tax quarterly period, as described in [subdivision \(b\) of section 1136 of the Tax Law](#), next commencing at least 60 days after this act shall have become a

law.
